- Selection of drivers and partners, properly trained, who meet all the conditions set by the company and the legislation
- Continuous training and development of personnel in Road Traffic Safety issues
- Use of appropriate, reliable, approved and up-to-date equipment, including patrol vehicles
- Implementation and monitoring of Road Traffic Safety Indicators & Targets, systematic assessment of their effectiveness, as well as implementation of improvement actions
- Continuous and structured assessment - analysis of risk factors affecting Road Traffic Safety
- Continuous improvement of the Road Traffic Safety Management System and revision of the Road Traffic Safety Policy when necessary.
