

Quality Policy

Nea Odos S.A. is committed to the application of the highest quality standards for the management of the Concession Project “Design, Planning, Construction, Operation, Exploitation and Maintenance Services of Motorway Ionia Odos (from Antirio to Ioanina), PATHE motorway (from Metamorfossi to Skarfia) and PATHE connecting branch Schimatari – Chalkida” as stated in the Concession Agreement. Nea Odos S.A. considers the adoption of an Integrated Management System (IMS) to be a matter of paramount importance and applies all necessary quality practices, control systems and certifications in order to:

- comply to the quality requirements specified in the Concession Agreement and
- meet the Concession Agreement’s obligations to the State, the relevant authorities and users.

In order to ensure that all the activities undertaken for the management of the Concession Project are of the required level of quality, Nea Odos S.A. operates an Integrated Management System which is progressively developed, implemented and certified according to the International Standard ISO 9001:2015. All parties involved in the Concession Project shall also implement relevant Management Systems which are to be compatible and interlinked with Nea Odos S.A.’s IMS. These Management Systems shall be certified according to ISO 9001 from an independent certification party.

The continuous improvement of the Integrated Management System constitutes a major priority for Nea Odos S.A. and regular audits, implementation of corrective actions and setting of quality targets is systematically undertaken. It is the CEO’s responsibility to ensure the consistent implementation of the Integrated Management System and the adherence to quality standards set therein. The Quality Manager is responsible for the continuous monitoring of the IMS implementation, as well as for the review of the set quality objectives, assuring the system’s effectiveness and development.

Nea Odos S.A. considers that the quality standards set through its IMS constitute a shared responsibility between the Management, employees and partners involved in the Concession Project and expects them to continuously promote quality improvement and advancement through the System’s implementation.
